From Timsbury, take the B3115 east, towards Bath. Come up the hill and keep driving through the village; after 1/2 mile or so, on your left will be Sarabeth Drive, just beyond that is an oak bus shelter. The drive to the TRC is almost opposite, just before the red telephone box (*directions copied from their website*)
